Dear Reader,

In this issue, we report on the European Commission's decision to circulate regional sugar prices in the EU to enhance market transparency while ensuring producers' confidentiality at the same time.

In some areas, management of poultry can be problematic. Gamat R'zina and co-workers co-composed carbonation line from a sugar factory together with poultry manure. They found that the addition of carbonation lime to poultry manure further improves its composting.

Damage resulting from harvest operations increases the storage losses of sugar beet. Christa Hoffmann and co-workers from the IZ Göttingen studied the impact of different harvesting systems and emphasized the importance of the operator of the harvesting machine for a good harvest quality.
